
## **ANIMAL CELLS AND DNA**

- All animals, including fish and humans, are made up of trillions of cells.
- The cell is the smallest building block in our body.
- All animal cells have structures in them called organelles to carry out the duties of the cell.



- 1. Nucleus Contains DNA (deoxyribonucleic acid) and controls all cell function.
- Mitochondria Changes sugars into energy for the cell. The energy is called ATP (adenosine triphosphate).
- 3. Lysosome Digests all nutrients delivered to the cell. Blood then carries the nutrients to each and every cell throughout your body.
